# Our Story

The Bundaberg Race Club Incorporated is a non-profit organisation, managed by volunteers and two part-time admin and grounds staff, hosting seven community race days a year. The Bundaberg Race Club is the home of thoroughbred racing in the Wide Bay, and is an important and leading non-TAB race club of the South East Country Racing Association.

The Bundaberg Race Club plays an important role in connecting the community in regional racing. Trainers and jockeys travel from Wondai, Eidsvold, Nanango, Gayndah, Gympie, Sunshine Coast, Toowoomba, and Brisbane to compete at Thabeban Park. As a training track, the racecourse also encourages local engagement in horse racing—allowing trainers to live, work, and compete locally. Bundaberg is a proud sporting community, with many patrons supporting our local racing events.

As well as promoting the racing industry, the Bundaberg Races have become popular community events with the Club's facilities and hospitality providing an environment for people to socialise with friends or network with colleagues and clients.

The Bundaberg Race Club partners with local suppliers and sponsors to produce community events for spectators to enjoy the excitement of a day at the races. The club provides a range of ticket packages from celebrating socially to hosting premium corporate functions.

All sponsorship and income generated from the Bundaberg Race Club events goes back into maintaining and improving our facilities and helps to boost the event budget for future community race days.

## Racing Carnival Overview

The annual Bundaberg Cup Racing Carnival is three days of entertainment, food, fashion, and fun built around the **Lindsay Australia Bundaberg Cup Race Day**.

Guests indulge in Bundaberg's iconic flavours, characters, and venues, and celebrate regional racing at its best.

Of the seven local race days held each year, the Bundaberg Cup Carnival is the Club's premium event. From the moment guests arrive, we want to build an atmosphere of excitement towards the main event: **Lindsay Australia Bundaberg Cup Race Day**.

The Bundaberg Cup three-day Racing Carnival began in 2018 and has grown each year to become a much-anticipated event on the regional racing calendar.

**Day 1** – Golf Day

**Day 2** – Calcutta Luncheon

**Day 3** – Race Day

The Bundaberg Cup Racing Carnival is the only three-day racing carnival in Queensland hosted by a non-TAB regional racing club and has boasted a list of high-profile racing industry guests including Black Caviar trainer Peter Moody, Group 1 winning jockey Jim “Pumper” Cassidy, Melbourne Cup Race Caller and Broadcaster Matt Hill, and Australian Hall of Fame Trainer David Hayes.



## Golf Day – Event Overview

The annual Bundaberg Toyota Golf Day forms Day 1 of the Carnival.

This Ambrose-style event is hosted at the Bundaberg Golf Club—an 18-hole Championship Golf Course (Par 71) located in North Bundaberg.

Players head out in two teams of three players and follow the Ambrose format, where each player takes a shot from the tee, after which the most favourable ball position is chosen. The players then continue taking shots from the best new position. This format allows golfers to mix and play together regardless of ability and promotes teamwork and fair play.

# Calcutta Luncheon – Event Overview

**The annual Next Payments Calcutta Luncheon forms Day 2 of the Carnival.**

This is a great warm-up event for the Club's feature Bundaberg Gold Cup 1380m Race. The Calcutta Luncheon will be hosted by SKY Race Callers Russell Leonard and Jarrod Wessel, with guest speakers including top trainer **Tony Gollan** and QLD Racing's jockey-glamour-couple **Ben Thompson and Stephanie Thornton**. Guests will arrive at Waves Sports Club and enjoy a two-course meal and all-inclusive drinks.

Calcutta tickets are sold on the day, and race form is provided by local bookmaker Robert Hooper. A raffle draw takes place for each horse in the feature 1380m Cup Race, and an auction then follows where guests bid to purchase horses in the Calcutta Field. The winning raffle ticket holder receives 50% of the winning bid if they sell their horse, or the winning raffle ticket holder only pays 50% to purchase the horse if they are the highest bidder. All the money from the raffle sales and auction creates the Calcutta Prize Pool, which is then split between the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Calcutta placegetters in the feature Cup race (70%/20%/10% respectively).


